LAV= lavender top tube; BLU= blue top tube; PST= green top tube; SST= red separator tube

Hematology

- LAV CBC** is a blood count that includes white cell types
- LAV Hemagram** a blood cell count without differential
- LAV Sed Rate** a non specific test for inflammation
- LAV Reticulocyte** an immature red blood cell
- SST Iron** – determines your iron level
- PST Ferritin** measures an iron transport protein
- SST Vitamin B12** test for anemia or low blood count
- SST Folate** folic acid level for anemia or low blood count
- BLU Protime/INR**, 3.0 to 4.5 for coumadin therapy
- BLU PTT** a test for heparin therapy or unusual bleeding
- BLU Fibrinogen** tests for bleeding problems
- BLU D-Dimer** tests for embolism or blood clot

Metabolics

- PST Ammonia *** a test for liver function
- PST BUN** a test of kidney function
- PST Calcium** determines your calcium level
- PST Creatinine** a test of kidney function
- PST Glucose** measures your blood sugar level
- PST LDH** a non specific test for liver or heart disease
- PST Magnesium** determines your magnesium level
- PST Phosphorous** measures your phosphorus level
- PST Potassium** determines your potassium level
- PST Uric Acid** a test for gout

* ICE= place tube into a Bio-bag of ice right After collection

Endocrine

- PST TSH** primary test for thyroid Function
- SST Free T4**, measures free T4, a thyroid test
- PST Thyroxine-** measures Total T4, a thyroid test
- LAV Hgb-A1C** used to monitor your diabetes management
- PST Cholesterol** determines your cholesterol level

Serology

- SST Rheumatoid Factor** a screening test for arthritis
- SST RPR** a screening test for syphilis
- SST ANA** a screening test for connective tissue diseases

Drug Levels

- PST Carbamazepine-** an anti-epileptic drug
- PST Digoxin** a drug to help make your heart beat better
- SST Lithium** used to monitor bi-polar disorder therapy
- PST Phenytoin** an anti-Epileptic drug
- PST Theophylline** a drug to help improve breathing
- PST Valproic acid** an anti-Epileptic drug

Infectious/Disease

- SST Monospot** a test for mono (Infectious mononucleosis)
- SWAB Throat Cx** tests for pathogens in your throat
- SWAB Grp A Strep** a test for group A strep in your throat
- SST HIV** tests for an antibody to human immunodeficiency virus- does NOT tell if you have AIDS

Cardio/GI

- PST CPK** test for heart or muscle damage
- PST Amylase** test for pancreatic disease
- PST Lipase** test for pancreatic disease
- PST ALT/SGPT** a liver function test
- PST Troponin** a test for cardiac damage
- PST BNP-nt** a test for (CHF) Congestive Heart Failure

Stool

- STL Stool C&S** tests for bacterial diseases
- STL C. diff toxin** is made by a bacteria, causes diarrhea
- STL Giardia antigen** test for this parasite in stool
- STL Fecal leuks** test for intestinal inflammation

Miscellaneous

- PST HCG, Qual-** pregnancy test- pos/neg result
- LAV Lead** test for lead poisoning
- PST PSA-monitor** test monitors prostate disease
- PST PSA-SCREEN** screens for prostate disease

Panels

- PST Electrolyte** (80051) - (panel includes Na, K, Cl, CO2)- also called - Lytes
- PST Basic Panel** (80048) - (panel includes BUN, Ca, Creat, Gluc, K, Na, Cl, CO2)- also called a BMP
- PST Renal Panel** (80069) - (panel includes Alb, Ca, CO2, Cl, Creat, Gluc, Phos, K, Na, BUN)- Kidney tests
- PST Hepatic Panel** (80076) - (panel includes Alb, Total & Direct Bili, Alk Phos, Total Protein, ALT, AST, GGT)- Liver tests
- SST Acute Hepatitis Panel** (80074) - (panel includes Hep A Ab-IgM, Hep B Core Ab-IgM, Hep B Surface Ag, Hep C Ab)- tests for active hepatitis
- PST Lipid Panel** (80061) - (panel includes Total cholesterol, triglycerides, HDL-cholesterol, LDL-cholesterol-calc)- Tests for cardiac disease/risk
- PST Comprehensive Metabolic Panel** (80053) - (includes Glucose, BUN, creat, Na, K, Cl, CO2, Ca, total protein, Alb, total bili, Alk phos, ALT, AST)
